

# Download Liliuokalani, Queen Of Hawaii

Lili'uokalani (Hawaiian pronunciation: [liʻiliʻuokʻʻʻni]); born Lydia Lili'u Loloku Walania Kamaka'eaha; September 2, 1838 – November 11, 1917) was the first queen regnant and the last sovereign monarch of the Kingdom of Hawai'i, ruling from January 29, 1891, until the overthrow of the Kingdom of Hawai'i on January 17, 1893. In commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the passing of Queen Lili'uokalani, Hawai'i's last reigning monarch, the Hawai'i State Archives is pleased to announce the digital release of the Queen Lili'uokalani Photograph Exhibition. Lili'uokalani Park and Gardens is a 24.14-acre (97,700 m<sup>2</sup>) park with Japanese gardens, located on Banyan Drive in Hilo on the island of Hawai'i.
