Yeats (1871-1957) is perhaps best known for his impressionistic paintings of early twentieth century Irish life. One of the last bushrangers, and by far the most famous, he is best known for wearing a suit of bulletproof armour during his final shootout with the police.. Kelly was born in the British colony of Victoria as the third of eight children to Irish parents.
