A novel is a relatively long work of narrative fiction, normally written in prose form, and which is typically published as a book.. The entire genre has been seen as having "a continuous and comprehensive history of about two thousand years", with its origins in classical Greece and Rome, in medieval and early modern romance, and in the tradition of the Italian renaissance novella. Kafka's last and longest novel, *The Castle*, was written in the shadow of death, and its snow-covered landscape contains no hint of green. Kafka didn't finish this novel, and he didn't want it to be published. Why did he write it? The poem consists of 124 lines, followed by the single word "Amen" and is recorded only at folios 81 verso - 83 recto of the Exeter Book, one of the four surviving manuscripts of Old English poetry.
